I learned the tune squared up, with a short 4-bar [B] part played twice (AABB), making it 8+8 bars, e.g. for a square or contra dance. But Henry Reed and others either play the [B] part four times, as shown here, or add minor variations to make a longer 8-bar [B] part, played twice. Either way it's non-square, with 8+16 bars.
